Patients and Methods

- Setting: 3 largest spa therapy resorts in France June 2006-April 2007
- Inclusion criteria: knee OA according to the American College Rheumatology criteria (painful knee OA x-ray and VAS pain ≥30mm +age≥50 and/or stiffness and/or crepitation)
- Exclusion criteria: OA limited PF joint; severe depression; a contraindication and others.
